### **About Award Nominations**

The Minnesota Hugh O-Brian Youth Leadership Organization invites you to nominate a youth or adult volunteer from your community who demonstrates the spirit of community service, volunteerism, and willingness to invest in the development of our future: our young people. Nominations are accepted at [2014 HOBY Leadership Award Nomination Entry](#) through January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2013.

Awards are available in three categories:

- **HOBY Outstanding Youth Award:** Awarded to an outstanding Minnesota youth, 13 to 18 years old, who has a consistent track record of volunteerism and clearly demonstrates a sense of social responsibility.
- **HOBY Outstanding Community Leadership Award:** Awarded to an adult who makes a difference in the lives of youth, with a focus on developing leadership and integrity in children and young people. The nominee must be 18 years of age or older.
- **Outstanding HOBY Alumnus Award:** An award given to a HOBY alumnus who continues to give back to the community. This person must be a HOBY alumnus, but does not need to be an alumnus of the Minnesota program.
